


- 1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to -20°C~+70°C.
- 2. From time to time when your vehicle is extremely hot or cold you must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle and for operating temperatures to return to normal operating ranges. - 3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (+/-30degrees).

- 6.Do not disconnect car power supply off while a disc is playing. It can cause damage to the DVD Player.



Remote Control

1 POWER

Turns the DVD Player & Unit on or off.

(2) MUTE

Press this button to switch off the audio during playback. Press again to restore the audio.

Use to move to the desired menu.

- (5) AVC MONITOR DVD-AV4 AV2
- (6) MENU (OSD on monitor) MONITOR Press this button to open the onscreen menu system to setup and control various parameters of the monitor and DVD player.

 Use to move to the desired menu.
- P/N This button permits you to choose among Multi, PAL and NTSC.

When a DVD is playing, press this button to view the Title Menu.

(13) DISPLAY


Show information of elapsed or remaining time of a chapter or a title.

14 PBC (Video CD only)

Press this button to access the special Playback Control functions for VCD 2.0 format Video CD's.

(15) NUMERIC button

Use when making a selection on the menu screen.

- 17 SETUP

Press this button to display the Setup menu. The Setup menu enables you to enter the settings required for the unit to work properly.

18 REPEAT

Press this button to change the playback mode to repeat, and to select the repeat mode.

Remote control

(29) FAST FORWARD/REVERSE PLAY

forward or fast reverse playback.

Use these buttons to select either fast

(19) A-B (repeat from A to B)

Use this button to select the beginning and end of a track which you wish to have repeat in playback.

(20) VOL-/+ button

Decrease the volume./ Increase the volume.

(21) AUDIO

Use this button to select one of the audio soundtracks programmed on a DVD disc. It is also used to select the audio output mode for the DVD playback.

22 ENTER

Press this button to confirm the item you have found and highlighted using the arrow buttons. Usually this is done to confirm a selection or item to be played on the DVD.

(23) **ZOOM**

If your DVD disc supports zooming in to see the program differently, pressing this button will enable you to change the amount of zoom.

(24) UP/DOWN/RIGHT/LEFT ARROWS

Use these buttons to navigate the various menus and screens for the monitor and DVD systems.

25 PLAY/PAUSE

To start playback of a disc, press this button. Press again to pause the playback. If playback is paused, press this button to resume playback.

(26) GOTO

Use to search a title or a chapter of your DVD disc.

(27) STOP

Press this button to stop the playback of the current disc.


(28) SKIP FORWARD/BACK






• How To Watch Monitor

1. Press the **MUTE** button on the remote control to mute the audio.


When the mute is on, press the **MUTE** button again on the remote control to play the audio.

1. Connect the external devices as shown in the picture on the right. (Refer Connection Diagram).







■ General Setup

1.TV Display

You can select a TV screen aspect ratio according to your TV. If the TV on which the movie is player -WIDE type, choose -EIDE. If it is of 4:3 type, choose NORMAL/PS (Pan&Scan) or NORMAL/LB(Letter BOX).



Normal / PS 4:3 PAN SCAN

Choose this setting if you want the movie to fill the entire screen. (This might mean that the left and right edges won't be seen)



Normal / LB 4:3 LET TERBO

Choose this setting if you want to see movie in their original aspect ratio. (The movie might appear with black bars at the top and bottom of the screen.)



Wide 16:9 WIDE SCREEN

Choose this setting if your DVD Player is connected to a widescreen TV. (This option is available only if the disc has a 16:9 display aspect ratio.)



Wide 16:9 Squeeze

Choose this setting if your DVD Player is connected to a widescreen TV. (This option is available only if the disc has a 16:9 display aspect ratio.)

This option is available only when the disc has the function.



2.Angle Mark

You can set up so that the angle mark appears on scenes.

On: When selected, the screen will be shown with angle mark.

Off: When selected, no angle mark is shown on the screen.

3.OSD Lang

Use this option to set the OSD language. When selected, change to set the on-screen display language.





4. Captions

Adjust caption selection.

On: Choose this setting to display captions.

Off: Choose this setting to close captions.

5. Screen Saver


The screen saver is useful to prevent your display from becoming damaged. The screen saver picture appears when you leave the DVD player in stop mode for about two minutes.


6.Last Memory



This function is more enhanced at low levels without distorting other frequencies.










Contrast





3. Audio

4.Subtitle

Use the subtitle language menu to select the subtitle language that you prefer. If the disc you are playing has that language available. It will display subtitles in that.



5.Disc Menu



6.Parental

The Parental feature is a rating limit system, like movie ratings. It works with DVD's that have been assigned a rating. This option lets you determine how your player will react to discs that contain movies that are rated(in the U.S.A.,the Motion Picture Association of America rates movies as G,PG,PG-13,etc.). You decide which ratings require a password and which ones don't.

- 1)Press the SETUP button when stop mode.
- 2)Press the ◀ / ► buttons to move to Preference.
- 3)Press the ▲ / ▼ buttons to move to Parental.
- 4)Press the ENTER button.
- 5)Press the ▲ / ▼ buttons to select desired parental level.



7. Country Region

Select parental region by pressing Country Region on the screen.

- 1)Press the SETUP button when stop mode.
- 2)Press the ◀ / ▶ buttons to move to Preference.
- 3)Press the ▲ / ▼ buttons to move to Country Region.
- 4)Press the ENTER button.

8.Default

If user selects reset from the setup menu, all the value of setup menu will be initialized by factory setting value. (Exception: Parental level, Region code and Password values will not be changed)




Connection diagram
